Coaches will also require a **Police Vulnerable Sector Check (PVSC)**. Forms can be picked up in the office for the Municipality of Brampton and Mississauga. If you live outside of Brampton and Mississauga, you will need a letter from the Club to take to your local Police Department. All Completed PVSC's need to be returned to the Office Manager for verification.

<p style="text-align: center;">Respect in Sport</p> 	<p>Ontario Soccer has partnered with the Respect Group to provide online education for coaches, referees and parents to help create a safe, healthy, and positive environment for children and youth involved in soccer.</p> <p>The Respect in Sport Program assists coaches, referees, trainers and managers with identifying and dealing with abuse, neglect, harassment and bullying in sport. All competitive (Rep) coaches must take the Respect in Sport Program, and it is highly suggested for recreational (House League) coaches. The online course curriculum is divided into six, 30-minute modules that can be completed at the user's own pace. <p>Make Ethical Decisions (MED)</p>	<p>Make Ethical Decisions (MED) is a course that is required for all coaches who take LTPD Coaching Courses.</p> <p>Coaches are required to attend the mandatory in-class MED course, which runs approximately 3 hours in length. Soccer for Life (U13+)	<p>Soccer for Life is a NCCP Community Coaching Workshops. The Canadian Soccer Association's LTPD workshops will give you the confidence to succeed as you enter the ranks of certified coaches in Ontario. Each level features education on age-appropriate coaching for each level of play.</p> <p>The emphasis of this course is on technical and tactical development within the 11-a-side game environment.</p> <p>This is a 16-hour course. An interactive workshop led by an expert facilitator with years of experience coaching soccer. You'll spend time in the classroom and on the field practicing drills. <p>New C License Course</p>	<p>The C License is a 4 day course that will predominately run over the course of two weekends. Hotels and meals will not be provided for the candidates.</p> <p>The C License course is NCCP recognized and will have 40 hours of theory and on-field education. All candidates attending the course are expected to participate in all aspects of the course. When the course has concluded, the attending coach will have the status of "in-training" registered on their profile in the NCCP locker. The coach will then have the option to have a post course on-field assessment six months following the conclusion of the course.</p> <p>If the coach is successful in meeting the standard during the assessment, his/her status will move from "in-training" to "Certified" on the locker and be awarded a C License certificate.</p> <p>Coaches must present their Soccer for Life OR Learn to Train certificate in addition to their proof of Respect in Soccer, Make Ethical Decisions and Making Head Way - Soccer Concussion E-Learning Module.</p>	<p>Set by Host</p>	<p>New C License Course</p>

Provincial B License Course	<p>4 days (residential) 4-days straight with 100% attendance required. Hotels and all meals are provided for the attendees.</p> <p>The course has a series of in-class and on-field practical sessions. It is mandatory that coaches are physically able to participate in all on-field sessions throughout the entire course. Coaches will be required to complete two (2) B Licence Assessments.</p> <p>The two assessments will be completed in two months post the B Licence course. The candidates will be provided Performance Centre location dates and candidates will be required to schedule their post course assessments. There will be no cost to the coaches for post course assessments.</p> <p>Coaches must present their successful Pre B Assessment / C License Certification plus a letter of recommendation to the Ontario Soccer in their application in addition to their proof of Respect in Soccer, Make Ethical Decisions and Making Head Way in Soccer Concussion E-Learning Module.</p>	Set by Host	Provincial B License Course
