### **OVERVIEW**

Brampton SC is a National Licensed Club in Canada dedicated to the development of well-balanced, successful players at the recreation, competitive and high-performance level.

The Club is seeking several highly motivated Head Coaches to work with our Grassroots Development Teams (U8-U12) within the Club for the 2022 Season.

### **POSITION SUMMARY**

An integral part of Brampton SC's Player Pathway is the Club's Grassroots Development Program which incorporates the FOUNDATION Stage (U8-U10) and the IMPROVE Stage (U11-U12) within the Clubs Curriculum.

The program operates year-round and provides U8-U12 players with access to standards-based District Level Competition and Training (Peel Region).

Brampton SC's Grassroots Development Players train and play in both Indoor and Outdoor competitions and train two(2) to three (3) times per week throughout the year.

The primary responsibility of the Head Coach will be to lead the ongoing implementation of BSC's Club Curriculum in accordance with Canada Soccer's Long-Term Player Development model. This position will oversee all aspects of team operations including training, games, player tracking, and off field management.

This position will also assist the Director of Soccer in operational planning and other organizational priorities.

The weekly workload does vary throughout the year, but on average Head Coaches work (4-5) hours on field and (1-2) hours on administration per team. Evening and weekend work is expected.

**PRIMARY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Provide Technical coaching to selected BSC Grassroots Team in line with BSC philosophy and Technical Plan
- Plan and execute all training sessions in line with BSC's Game Model, Technical Habits, and Training Methodology
- Lead teams in all competitions
- Ensure regular communication with the Director of Soccer to track the development of players within the program
- Ensure accurate records are maintained to track the development of players
- Work with the Club's Director of Soccer and Competitive Administrator to ensure effective communication exists between the Club and the families registered to our Competitive Program
