OVERVIEW

Brampton SC (BSC) is a National Licensed Soccer Club in Canada governed by a Board of Governors and operated by staff and volunteers dedicated to the development of well-balanced, successful players at the recreation, competitive and high-performance level. As a Community Club Brampton SC has contributed to the development of the game and has developed players who have gone on to play for the Canadian National Teams, Canadian and US Universities, as well as many Professional Clubs. We are committed to creating a proven pathway to the elite level for our male and female players. The Club is seeking highly motivated coaches to work within our Competitive Pathway (U13 to U21) for both Male and female Teams (NOTE: female role models for our female division as a priority).

POSITION(S) SUMMARY

Brampton SC has a desire to develop coaches who want to be mentored and evaluated on a consistent basis to excel personally! Hence, the ideal candidates subscribe to continual professional development and self-improvement to reach their full potential as a teacher of the game.

Youth (Rep) Coach is a PT paid position within the Brampton SC and therefore is expected to support Club initiatives and policies.

The primary accountability for the Head Coach of our competitive teams is to provide the leadership and guidance to develop the person before the player. The Head Coach is required to do the following:

Technical Responsibilities:

- Attend all training sessions as well as all games, tournaments, and other team events
- Travel within Peel Halton for league games as required.

- Attend BSC coach education workshops
- Support and implement the BSC Game Model, DNA and Curriculum.
- Schedule Exhibition games.
- Manage Fall Open Trials and player selections.
- Attend all mandatory meetings set by the Club's Technical Department, District or Provincial Association.
- Required to provide a standardized annual plan to the Director of Soccer
- Written goals and seasonal objectives for the competitive team
- Liaise with the Head Goalkeeper Coach
- Provide assessments of all players twice per year or as necessary per BSC Policies. (Mid-season & end of season)
- Head Coaches must make themselves available for individual parent meetings following the distribution of these assessments
- Agree to attract and maintain the minimum number of required players 16
- Communicate in a timely manner to respond to requests of the Technical Staff and other BSC staff

Qualifications:

- Minimum Soccer 4 Life, 'C' License preferred with enrollment in the CSA National Youth License
- BSC will support coaches and approve any community license they wish to register for, but this must be approved by the Director of Soccer prior to registration.
- Limited to one coaching education course per calendar year.
- Clean Vulnerable Sector Police check is a mandatory policy •
- Valid Driver's License Skills and Competencies
- Must hold and submit a valid Canada Soccer coaching license (age appropriate)
(All Online Courses Below which are mandatory to pursue 'C' License)
 - Making Ethical Decisions transcript,
 - Respect in Soccer certificate,
 - Making Headway transcript,
 - Safe Sport,
 - Emergency Action Plan,
 - Mental Health in Sport with signed contract
 - Coaches working with female players must also complete Keeping Girls in Sport Skills & Competencies

Skills/Competencies:

- Excellent communicator with demonstrated interpersonal and communication skills
- Experience and knowledge with coaching children
- Demonstrated experience in building and maintaining strong relationships

- Demonstrated proficiency in the use of common technology and computer platforms
- Subscribes to continual professional development and self-improvement
- Flexibility to work off-business hours such as evenings and weekends
- Physical capacity to demonstrate and execute regular on-field and off field training sessions.
- Be the primary contact for any player or parent issues for the youth team 3
- Be an active participant in the BSC coaching staff and contribute to the betterment of the Club coaching standards.

The Youth (Rep) Head Coach will be supported by:

- Director of Soccer to mentor with intentions of acquiring their next applicable license
- Assistant Coach – to be mentored to obtain the necessary experience to be a Head Coach
- GK Coach – handles weekly GK training
- Team Manager – administrative details and communications to the parents

All Head Coaches will be supplied with Diadora coaching attire, and this is mandatory to be worn to all training/games/tournaments etc.
